Some years later, after Ad Plaizier had conducted a marketing survey, Marcelle was asked whether he would agree to appoint an Associate Editor from the U.S. The market survey showed that international coverage of the journal should be improved. Many scientists also enthusiastically suggested the appointment of Govindjee. Marcelle agreed to this appointment and subsequently Govindjee was invited and accepted this position beginning with volume 4 (number 1). Govindjee's new position at the Editorial Board of Photosynthesis Research was announced at the 6th International Photosynthesis Congress in Brussels (Belgium), August 1-6, 1983. In 1985, Govindjee was slated to become Co-EIC [starting from Vol. 6 (3)]; this move was to further strengthen the international coverage as well as to expand the expertise ...
